For seniors facing food insecurity, we provide nutritious home-delivered meals, emergency shelf-stable food packages, and supplemental nutrition.
Second Helpings Atlanta (SHA)	Second Helpings Atlanta is a nonprofit food rescue organization whose mission is to reduce hunger and food waste in the Metro Atlanta area by rescuing healthy, nutritious surplus food and distributing it to those in need.
International Rescue Committee	The International Rescue Committee (IRC) in Atlanta creates opportunities for refugees and immigrants to integrate and thrive in Georgia communities. To assist families in reuniting and rebuilding their lives in the greater Atlanta area, IRC offers a broad range of programs including resettlement and case management services, adult education classes, youth programs covering ages 5 to 24, employment assistance, asset building resources, community health response programs, and immigration services.

	GAIN's most recent effort is Project Ally, launched in August 2021 in response to the crisis in Afghanistan. Project Ally is an emergency immigration relief effort for Afghan families in Georgia and beyond, which has already provided legal immigration support to hundreds of displaced Afghan nationals.
GA Justice Project (GJP)	Georgia Justice Project strengthens our community by demonstrating a better way to represent and support individuals in the criminal justice system and reduce barriers to reentry into the community. GJP promotes innovative change through direct legal representation, policy advocacy, education, and coalition building.
	<b>Grant purpose:</b> to support GJP's re-entry (after incarceration) legal services and social service support.
Operation Feed ATL	<b>Mission:</b> to be a reliable and consistent food resource partner to the Atlanta Public School community. Our aim is to provide hunger relief to children and their families throughout the Atlanta Public School System who might be facing food insecurity. We do this through a network of volunteers who procure food donations and host food drives and distribute throughout the community.
	Grant purpose: to support establishment of new food pantries in APS schools
Street Grace	Street Grace is a faith-based organization that utilizes evidence-based demand reduction strategies to eradicate the Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children (CSEC).
	<b>Grant purpose:</b> To support Street Grace's Prevention & Protection programs: Youth Education Initiative, Faith Outreach, Street Grace and Law Enforcement Training, and Street Teams.
GA Conservancy	Mission: to protect Georgia through ecological and economic solutions for stewardship, conservation and sustainable use of the land and its resources. Grant purpose: to support the Women's Hiking Group in partnership with the Refugee Women's Network. Now in its third year, the program facilitates healthy activity, community integration and inclusion, and environmental stewardship for a group of women survivors of war, conflict and displacement.
Childspring International	Mission: to provide life-changing surgeries for children from developing countries and, as a result, transform communities.  Grant purpose: to support in-country surgeries for children from the island of La Gonave and elsewhere in Haiti.
