# **Sunday Morning Offerings**

#### CONNECTIONS

Connections is a discussion-based class that explores a reading. podcast, or video that has been shared before the class meeting. The gathering is mostly member-led, with occasional conversations facilitated by pastoral staff. Reading or listening ahead is helpful, but not required.



#### **FOUNDATIONS**

Foundations is a member-led, discussion-based class that focuses on discovering new meaning in familiar scripture each week. Advance preparation is not required.

#### WILLIAMS HALL PRESENTATION

Each week, there is also a presentation-based class offered in Williams Hall, often with an outside speaker who is an expert on the topic at hand. These offerings will also include time for discussion and questions during or after the presentation. Advance preparation is not required. The weekly Williams Hall class is livestreamed.

#### **CFM Sunday School**

9:45 AM, Gathering in the Gym 10:00 AM, Building D Children's Classrooms

We often get asked, "When does Sunday school start?" At Trinity, ALL children, starting from infancy, experience the love of Jesus Christ through age-appropriate lessons.

Our curriculum aligns children's classes with the Bible stories taught in the Foundations class, helping children learn and engage with new and familiar stories. Classes are led by CFM Committee members, Trinity members, and parents and include interactive activities to build relationships.

We hope families will discuss what they've learned in Sunday school during the week.





#### **FOUNDATIONS**

#### SCHOOL CLASS

One of the Sunday morning offerings is aptly titled Foundations. To determine if Foundations is a good fit for you, consider the following scenario (which, unfortunately, is more realistic than I'd like it to be):

#### Picture This:

It's noon on Sunday, and your family is loading into the car after a restful and restorative morning at church. Just as you settle into the driver's seat, your child asks one or more of the following questions:

A. "Hey Mom, how did Elijah's altar catch on fire?"

B. "Hey Dad, was Lazarus really dead or just sleeping?"

C. "Hey! Why was he called John the Baptist and not John the Presbyterian?"

Panic sets in. You can't remember those stories! You can't even recall the lessons you're supposed to learn from them! (And, if you're honest, those stories sound downright bizarre without any context.) You might respond in one of two ways:

You quickly make something up.

a. Pro: It could be fun.

b. Con: Generally frowned upon. (You do remember something about "Thou shalt not lie.")

You admit you don't remember (or perhaps never knew) that particular Bible story.

a. Pro: No false witness for you!

b. Con: You miss a rare opportunity to engage meaningfully with your child about their spiritual development.

If this scenario seems familiar, Foundations is the class for you! Join us as we explore Bible stories in an interactive, discussion-oriented setting. Not an expert? Not a problem.

This class is for individuals looking to fellowship with other Trinity members while growing their faith through Bible reading, reflection, questioning, and applying Jesus' teachings to their lives.

Bring your Bible (and a sense of humor), and let's grow together.


#### **MESSY CHURCH**
