Two-Year-Olds – Pre-K (4 year olds) D106

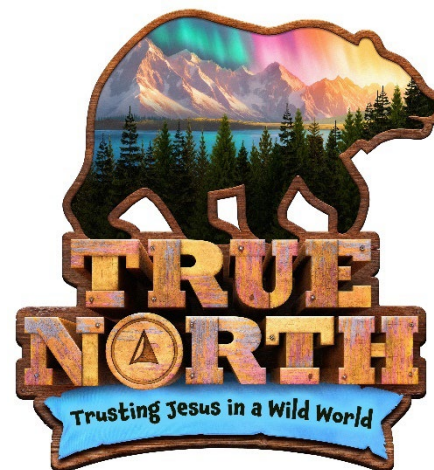
Flowers
