CUBA MISSION TRIP

Living Waters for the World

Living Waters for the World (LWW) trains volunteers to establish and lead water mission teams that partner with communities to implement and operate sustainable water purification systems and health education programs. These teams provide essential support for sustainable water systems that produce clean water for a generation. Since 1993, Living Waters for the World has shared clean water with over 1,000 communities across 26 countries. (Over 25 of which are in Cuba.)

In the past year, Trinity formed a Water Filtration System team to travel to Cuba and partnered with Matanzas Evangelical Theological Seminary (our long-time mission partner) to implement the installation of a new water filtration system in the satellite campus in Havana, Cuba. Next week, this group will travel to Cuba for a site development visit.
